The Perham Resource Recovery Facility (PRRF) is a Waste-To-Energy (WTE) facility that incinerates municipal solid waste and generates steam energy purchased by nearby businesses. The PRRF also has a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) for removing non-combustible and recyclable materials from the waste stream.

Opened in 1986, the PRRF underwent a large renovation and expansion process in 2013/2014. With the ability to process more waste and stricter air emissions, the waste-to-energy facility reduces the amount of waste going to landfills and is a preferred method of waste disposal.
