Pope/Douglas Solid Waste Management is a partnership created by Pope and Douglas County in 1983. This partnership was created to manage the solid waste generated in both counties. Since then several counties have contracted with PDSWM to process their waste at the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) and Waste-to-Energy (WTE) Facilities.

- Began processing waste in March of 1987
- Recycling program began in December of 1988
- 2011 – 3rd Combustion Unit added to increase combustion capacity from 120 tons/day to 240 tons/day
- Facility is running at Full Capacity
- 44% Recycling Rate for Pope/Douglas Counties
- Year-round Household Hazardous Waste Facility
